- By Mail: Download the Spring Session Registration form, available on our website. New skaters need to complete both pages of the form.
- Online: Send an email requesting the online payment option and be sure to include the skater's first and last name and date of birth to ppfscbasicskills@earthlink.net. You will be sent a PayPal invoice to complete the payment process using your credit card. (There will be a \$2 service charge added onto all credit card payments.) The completed hard copy of the registration form will need to be submitted on the first day of class.
