****Information for skaters who are just beginning our program:** Basic 1 and Snowplow Sam levels are for beginners. Snowplow Sam is designated for ages 3-4. Snowplow Sam classes are 25 minutes of instruction only. Basic Level 1 is for ages 5 and up. Classes include a 25-minute lesson with a coach and 25 minutes of practice time.
