Class dates: Classes run from January 6-March 3; no classes on January 20 and February 17; seven classes in all.

Class Time: Basic Badge level classes take place from 11:00-11:50 a.m. Snowplow Sam* classes will be held either at 11:00-11:25 a.m. or at 11:25-11:50 a.m. The actual time will be based on enrollment.

How to enroll:

- By mail: Mail the completed registration form for the Winter Session available on our website. Registrations must be postmarked by Thursday, December 27.
- Online: Check our website for details about online registration.
- In person: Come to our Open House on Saturday, December 29, from 1-2 p.m. at Schneider Arena. Interested skaters can try out our program for free!

Registrations received after December 29 will be accepted on a space-available basis and will incur higher prices. Please contact us to verify there is room.

***Basic 1 and Snowplow Sam levels are for beginners.** Snowplow Sam is designated for ages 3-4. Classes are 25 minutes of instruction only. Basic Level 1 is for ages 5 and up. Classes include 25 minutes of instruction and 25 minutes of practice time.
