Dear Skaters,

PPFSC will have ice available at Schneider Arena, Providence College, on Sunday mornings from 8:00am-10:50am. These sessions are designated Open Combined.

11:00am-11:50am is designated as Learn to Skate / Open Combined. We are allowing a limited number of private lessons to take place on Learn to Skate ice, provided the private lesson students are not skating through the group lessons that are taking place.

Schneider Arena ice dates: Sunday, September 11, 2022-March 19, 2023

No-ice Dates

The following dates are currently listed as no-ice dates. It is possible that other dates will be added at a later time. In the event that happens, you will be notified and your total payment will be adjusted accordingly.

All sessions: October 2, October 9, December 25

September 11: 10 a.m. & 11a.m. sessions only will not be held; the 8 & 9 a.m. will not be affected

The following **requirements** must be met to skate on our club sessions:

Open Combined: All levels MIF/Freestyle/Dance – **No Pairs** (This exclusion does not apply to similar pairs / duets or dance.)

APPLICATION DEADLINE – Applications accompanied by the deposit must be postmarked by Saturday, September 10, 2022. The remaining balance is payable in monthly installments. Haoli Li will send statements.

Late fee: \$20 for applications not postmarked by the deadline.

Please remember that all skaters must have a current USFS membership in order to skate on any PPFSC session. Please have your membership card available if you are not a PPFSC member. If you have any questions, contact Haoli at lihaoli@gmail.com

- There will be a \$20 fee added to your bill for each check that is returned to us for insufficient funds.
- Skaters are placed on sessions in the order in which the assistant treasurer receives the applications up until the deadline. Full members are given first consideration, associates next, then non-members. After the deadline, only the postmark is the deciding factor.
- You may not drop a session once it has begun.
- The Board of Governors reserves the right to change the level requirements or discipline of any session that is under-enrolled.
- Please check our Facebook page and website for updates and changes.

All *summer ice bills must be paid in full* before the fall/winter application will be accepted. A deposit of **\$100** must accompany application before it will be accepted. We are looking forward to an enjoyable, productive year ahead.

Learn to Skate USA

We will be offering a *Learn to Skate USA* Program at Providence College on Sundays. Please check our website for the most up-to-date information.

Service Requirement

The Board has established the requirement that each skater who contracts ice time or purchases a Season Pass, work four hours at one of the Club's fundraising activities, such as the Providence Open. The proceeds from fundraisers, such as this, are being used to subsidize the ice bills of PPFSC skaters, and we need workers to ensure that we are indeed able to successfully run these activities. There will be a variety of options that will be available for service time, assuring that everyone will be able to meet the obligation without difficulty.

Some of the events/activities that will provide service opportunities include:

- the Providence Open - September 10-11, 2022
- Learn to Skate Program on Sundays
- PPFSC Holiday Exhibition-TBD
- LeeAnn Miele Synchronized Skating Open- January 14-15, 2023

The service time can be fulfilled by either an adult family member or the skater of an appropriate age. A fee of \$100 will be added to the January ice bill of every skater who does not fulfill the requirement.

The Season Pass

We are offering this option to skaters who are unable to make a commitment to contracted ice time, but purchase many walk-ons over the course of the season. The Season Pass involves the purchase of a package of 20 walk-on passes for the upcoming season. This will cost less than the equivalent number of walk-ons at the regular rate. The advantage of the Season Pass is that it allows flexibility over the course of the season.

The Season Pass

- will be treated like a contract and will incur music fees and the service requirement as described above;
- does not guarantee a spot on the ice; it can only be used if space is available;
- is to be used by only one skater, just like a contracted session; and
- is valid only for the fall/winter season.

In addition, a skater with a Season Pass will be given the priority for a place on an ice session over a regular walk-on.

*****Session administrator (Admin)** We have changed the title of this duty to better reflect what is involved. A fee of \$75 will be added to the ice bill of a skater who does not act as a Session Admin for 7 sessions during this season. This includes the following duties:

- turning on PA system at PC
- setting up / putting away boom box at the beginning / end of club ice sessions
- taking attendance & collecting walk-on payments

You can avoid this charge by acting as a Session Admin for 7 sessions. Please note that we are not collecting this fee in advance. DO NOT add it to your ice bill, unless you so not want to act as a Session Admin. In that case, please add \$75 fee to your ice bill.

This fee is charged per skater. Volunteer is responsible for fulfilling this obligation for each skater in the family who contracts ice. ***PLEASE READ PAGE 7 FOR DETAILED DESCRIPTION OF MUSIC DUTIES.***

All walk-on fees must be paid prior to walking on the session.
