Information and Registration for our Summer Session

Classes in our summer program will be held on Tuesdays from 5:00-5:50 p.m. at Lynch Arena in Pawtucket.

- **Basic Badge Level** classes are for skaters 5 years old and above, including adults. : Basic classes take place from 5:00-5:50 p.m. There are 25 minutes of lesson time with a coach and 25 minutes for practice
- **Snowplow Sam** classes are for those who are 3-5 years old. Snowplow Sam classes will be held at 5:25-5:50 p.m. These skaters have 25 minutes of lesson with a coach. There is no additional time for practice.

Acceptance of Risk

I acknowledge and accept these risks and agree to hold harmless the Pawtucket & Providence Figure Skating Club as well as its directors, officers, agents and rink employees in so far as the laws of the State of Rhode Island permit.

I accept the stated risks and limitations and am at least 18 years of age. For minors under the age of 18, a parent or guardian must sign and accept the risks and limitations for their child. Signing this document is a binding legal contract.
