The Providence Open/Little New Englands will be conducted in accordance with the rules and regulations of U.S. Figure Skating, as set forth in the current rulebook, as well as any pertinent updates that have been posted on the U.S. Figure Skating website.

PLEASE NOTE:

IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PARENT, COACH AND SKATER TO REVIEW THE <u>U.S. FIGURE SKATING WEBSITE</u> FOR THE REQUIREMENTS FOR EACH OF THE EVENTS OFFERED AT THE PROVIDENCE OPEN AND LITTLE NEW ENGLANDS.

This competition is open to all eligible, restricted, reinstated or readmitted persons as defined by the Eligibility Rules, and who are currently registered member of a U.S. Figure Skating member club, a collegiate club or who is an individual member in accordance with the current rulebook.

Foreign Skaters Non-U.S. skaters intending to register for this competition must set up a non-member account prior to registering for the competition (<u>click here for HOW TO</u>). This can be done by choosing the "Non-Member? Create Account" option on the <u>Members Only</u> login page.

ELIGIBILITY/TEST LEVEL:

Test level: Competition level is the highest test passed as of the entry deadline, in the discipline the skater is entering. Entrants may skate one level above that for which they qualify, but they may not skate down in any event.

Age Restrictions/Requirements:

Singles free skate events have the following requirements: Juvenile Girls-12 years or younger;
Boys -13 years or younger
Open Juvenile-13 years or older;
Boys 14 years or older
Intermediate must be under the Age of 18

The maximum age for a Little New England Event is 18 years old. Skaters may enter only <u>one</u> Little New England Event.

Skaters entering pre-juvenile and lower events will be divided as closely as possible by age, should the number of entries warrant more than one group.

For all events where permitted by USFS, if there are insufficient entries to hold a separate event, male and female skaters may compete against each other. PPFSC reserves the right to limit the size of each event, to cancel an event, to combine and/or divide groups if necessary. In addition, the LOC may cancel or alter an event due to time constraints.



ENTRIES:

Entries will only be accepted online via http://www.entryeeze.com. Online registration closes midnight on August 14, 2022. Late entries will be accepted until August 21 at the discretion of the LOC with a \$50.00 late fee.

Registration fees are paid by credit card only and include a 4% non-refundable credit card processing fee paid by the skater.

JUDGING SYSTEM

The 6.0 Judging System will be used for all events.

Practice Ice: unofficial practice ice (no music) will be available at a cost of \$20.00 for 15 minutes and can be pre- purchased online through via Entryeeze. If availability permits, any unsold ice will be available onsite for \$25.00 for 15 minutes.

REFUND POLICY: Entry fees will not be refunded after August 14, 2022 unless no competition exists or the event is canceled. There will be no refunds for medical withdrawals. Contested credit card charges will be assessed a \$25.00 fee. Payment of these fees will be required before the skater is allowed to participate in practice ice or events. Credit card processing fees are NOT refundable.

SCHEDULE: Competitors may be scheduled on any day or time for the announced dates of the competition. The competition and practice ice schedule will be available via Entryeeze as soon as possible after the close of entries. All participants will be notified via email once available. The schedule will also be posted at www.ppfsc.org once it is available,

MUSIC UPLOAD:

DEADLINE: AUGUST 22th at 11:59 PM

After this deadline, skaters will be locked out of the music upload and assessed a \$25.00 late fee All competition music must be electronically submitted via Entryeeze through the Music & Program Content tab no later than August 22, 2022. All music must meet the criteria as stated in this announcement. If you have questions about what format you have, please contact your coach and get a new version of your music that meets the criteria listed below.

REGISTRATION: Registration will begin one hour before the first event and run through the last event of the day. The registration table will be located in the main lobby of Schneider Arena. Please register promptly on arrival.

LOCKER ROOMS AND CHANGING AREAS: US Figure Skating policy toward locker rooms can be found in Safe Sport Handbook. Please review for detailed information.

PRACTICE ICE: Practice Ice: Unofficial practice ice (no music) will be available at a cost of \$20.00 for 15 minutes and can be pre- purchased online through via EntryEeze. Sessions will be self-scheduled by skaters after the competition schedule has been released. If availability permits, any unsold ice will be available onsite for \$25.00 for 15 minutes.

PHOTO/VIDEO: There is no photography scheduled at this time, subject to change. **AWARDS:** Medals will be presented for the 1st,2nd, 3rd and 4th place finishers. Trophies will be presented to the top four finishers in the final round of the Little New England Competition. A trophy will be presented to the winner of the Herb Kaplan Fourteen Step; medals will be given to the 2nd, 3rd and 4th place finishers.

<u>OFFICIAL NOTICES:</u> To receive the schedule for the competition as well as any news on the competition, refer to <u>www.ppfsc.org</u>It is the responsibility of each competitor, parent, and coach to check the website frequently for any schedule changes and/or additional information. Skaters are requested to arrive 1 hour prior to the scheduled time of their event. A tentative schedule ofevents will be posted prior to the competition.

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR ALL COACHES:

All coaches must be fully compliant per USFS rules. They should bring proof of compliance to the competition.

- Completed background check (green light status)
- Completed SafeSport Training*
- Continuing Education Requirements (CERs) for the 2019-20 Competition Season
- Proof of current general liability insurance with limits of \$1 million per occurrence/\$5 million aggregate.

Coaches of Compete USA athletes:

- Learn to Skate USA Instructor membership OR U.S. Figure Skating full membership
- Completed SafeSport Training* (for coaches 18 years old and over)
- Completed background check (green light status) (for coaches 18 years old and over)



• Learn to Skate USA Instructor Certification completed (for coaches under 18 years old)

*SafeSport training is available through http://www.usfsaonline.org for full members of U.S. Figure Skating (through Learn to Skate USA portal for instructors). There is no cost to this training and certification is valid for 2 seasons.

The PPFSC will have a list of compliant coaches which is verified through the U.S. Figure Skating database; they will receive a credential at the competition. Coaches will need to check in at the event registration desk and show a government issued photo I.D. to receive a credential.

If a coach cannot provide a photo I.D. and is not on the list or cannot produce the necessary documents, he or she will not be allowed a credential. There can be no exceptions to this policy.

Notice to Coaches: U.S. Figure Skating is implementing small changes to the Excel Program, which are effective September 1 and were unavailable to PPFSC for inclusion in this application. Those changes will be posted mid-summer. The association encourages coaches to check the 2022-23 season requirements chart at usfigureskating.org/ programs/excel series for those changes.



Music Criteria and Requirements

For the 2022 Providence Open, online music submission is the ONLY acceptable method to submit program music. After you have paid for your events, the system will prompt you to upload your music for each event that requires music. If your music is not available at that time, you can logout of your account and return later to upload your music by going to the "Competition" tab and then selecting "My Music." Please be sure you are uploading the correct music for the correct event segment. Be careful, for example, not to mix up your short program and your free skate! All music must be uploaded by August 22, 2022, 11:59PM ET). Please confirm the exact date on EntryEeze.

The uploaded program music MUST conform to the following specifications:

Programs per file: One (1) - Only one piece of competition program music (e.g. short

program, free skate, short dance, free dance, etc.) per file is allowed.

File Format: mp3 - The uploaded file music must be an mp3 file (MPEG-1 or MPEG-2

Audio Layer III). Simply changing the file extension to "mp3" from

another file for amat is not acceptable.

Bit Rate: 192 kbps is requested (bit rates between 128 and 320 kbps will be

accepted).

Maximum file size: 10 MB

Maximum run time: Five (5 minutes)

ID3 Metadata (tags): None - The Chief Music Coordinator strongly requests that mp3

files DO NOT contain any ID3 metadata, commonly called tags. This is especially true of any embedded images such as album cover art, picture

of the skater, etc. Please, NO EMBEDDED IMAGES!

Maximum leader: The Chief Music Coordinator requests that there be NO leader. The

leader is the silence between the start of the track and the actual start of

the program music.

Maximum trailer: The Chief Music Coordinator requests that there be NO trailer. The trailer

is the silence between the end of the program music and the end of the

actual track.

Backup Music at Event (CDs)

In addition to submitting the music online, all competitors/teams must also have at least one (1) backup copy of their competition music on CD, AT RINKSIDE, during the actual competition event segment or official practice. CDs must meet the following requirements:

- In standard Audio CD format (Compact Disc Digital Audio). Other formats, including mp3 are NOT acceptable.
- Clearly marked with a permanent marker (e.g. Sharpie, do NOT use a label or tape) as follows: First Name, Last Name, (Club Optional but requested), Event, Event



Segment and Music Length (e.g. Jane Smith, Acme FSC, Novice Ladies, Free Skate, 3:10 or Synchro Team, Widget FSC, Preliminary, Free Skate, 1:59)

- Each CD may have only ONE (1) music track on it. In the case where a skater competes in both a short program/dance and a free skate/free dance, two (2) separate discs must be available. Any disc with more than one (1) track is NOT acceptable.
- Lead in time (time before the music begins) on CDs may not exceed two (2) seconds.
- Due to the compatibility and reliability reasons, music may NOT be submitted on rerecordable "CD-RW" discs. PLEASE, no CD-RWs!!

The Local Organizing Committee ("LOC"), competition officials, and volunteers exercise reasonable care when handling CDs. However, they are not responsible for damage to or loss of any CDs. The LOC is not responsible for CDs not picked up by the end of the competition. Those CDs will be destroyed.

Interruption in Music – U.S. Figure Skating Rule 1403

If, after the competitor/team's name has been called to compete, there is an issue with the downloaded music or CD provided at the event, the competitor will have up to 3 minutes to rectify the situation with a backup copy of the music on CD. After 3 minutes, the competitor/team will be considered withdrawn.

Administrative Fee for Incorrect Music or Failure to Upload Music

The LOC may assess each competitor/team an additional charge, up to \$25.00 per event segment, to manually handle a team's music, if the competitor/team: 1) fails to submit their music prior to the close of online music submission, 2) submits files that do not follow the specifications above, or 3) uploads the incorrect music for a given event segment (e.g. uploads short program music instead of the free skate). In the event the LOC decides to assess an administrative fee, the competitor/teams will not receive their credentials at registration until they pay the fee and turn in their music on CD, conforming to the requirements above.
